| Requirements | Ralph Bergen / Don Martin Scholarship Fund | Hazel Burnett Scholarship Fund |

| eligible grades | college freshman & sophomore | college junior & senior |
| member St. Andrew | affiliated with St. Andrew (not necessarily membership) | Membership required or child of member |
| GPA | Sonoma Valley High School top 25% of class, 2.8 cumulative college GPA | college 2.8 or greater |
| high school | graduate of Sonoma Valley High School | Graduate of any high school |

- Scholarships are awarded at the beginning of the fall and spring semesters based upon work completed the previous semester (or year)
- All applicants must be full-time college students at an accredited college or university
- Financial need is not a consideration. Scholarship awards may vary depending on number of applicants and funds available due to performance of the market
- **First-time applicants** for each scholarship must:
 - (1) Complete the application form,
 - (2) Submit a letter explaining reason for requesting scholarship,
 - (3) Submit two letters of recommendation,
 - (4) Submit a current **official transcript** verifying eligibility for the specific scholarship,
 - (5) Submit proof of college enrollment (college acceptance letter, copy of tuition payment receipt, official class schedule)
 - (6) Indicate in your letter of interest, the mailing address to where the scholarship check is to be mailed.
- All scholarships are renewable, based on satisfaction of requirements
- **Continuing applicants** must:
 - (1) Submit a letter of interest,
 - (2) Submit an **official college transcript**,
 - (3) Submit proof of current college enrollment (copy of tuition receipt or copy of official class schedule)
 Further application forms are not necessary for the same scholarship
 - (4) Indicate in your letter of interest, the mailing address to where the scholarship check is to be mailed.
- Application deadlines are published on the Website (andrewpres.org) and weekly bulletin announcements for at least one month prior to deadline
- All application materials, for new and returning applicants, must be submitted to the Scholarship Commission **prior to the published deadline** in order to be eligible for consideration for scholarships.
